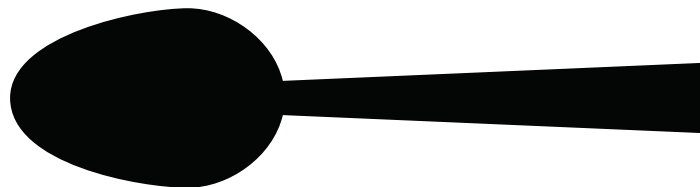

BCM GROCERY LIST TO FEED A FAMILY OF FOUR

Tear this list along the dotted line and take it with you on your next shopping trip. The purchased food can be placed in the BCM bin in the Welcome Center.

- Instant oatmeal or grits- 1 box
- Jelly- 1 small jar
- Soup- 4 cans
- Dried beans- 1 bag
- Rice- 2 bags
- Peanut butter- 2 small jars
- Cornbread mix- 2 boxes
- Macaroni & cheese- 4 boxes
- Chicken broth- 2 cans
- Spaghetti noodles- 1 medium box
- Spaghetti sauce- 2 jars
- Canned vegetables- 4 cans
- Canned beans- 3 cans
- Canned tuna- 4 cans
- Ramen noodles- 5 packages

Please do not purchase “family size” packages. Most BCM clients have to take their food on the bus and large packages are too difficult to carry.
